Sports Ambassadors play a very important role in representing Burgess Sports values and ethos. Ambassadors are the first role models followed by our young participants; therefore we expect from them:

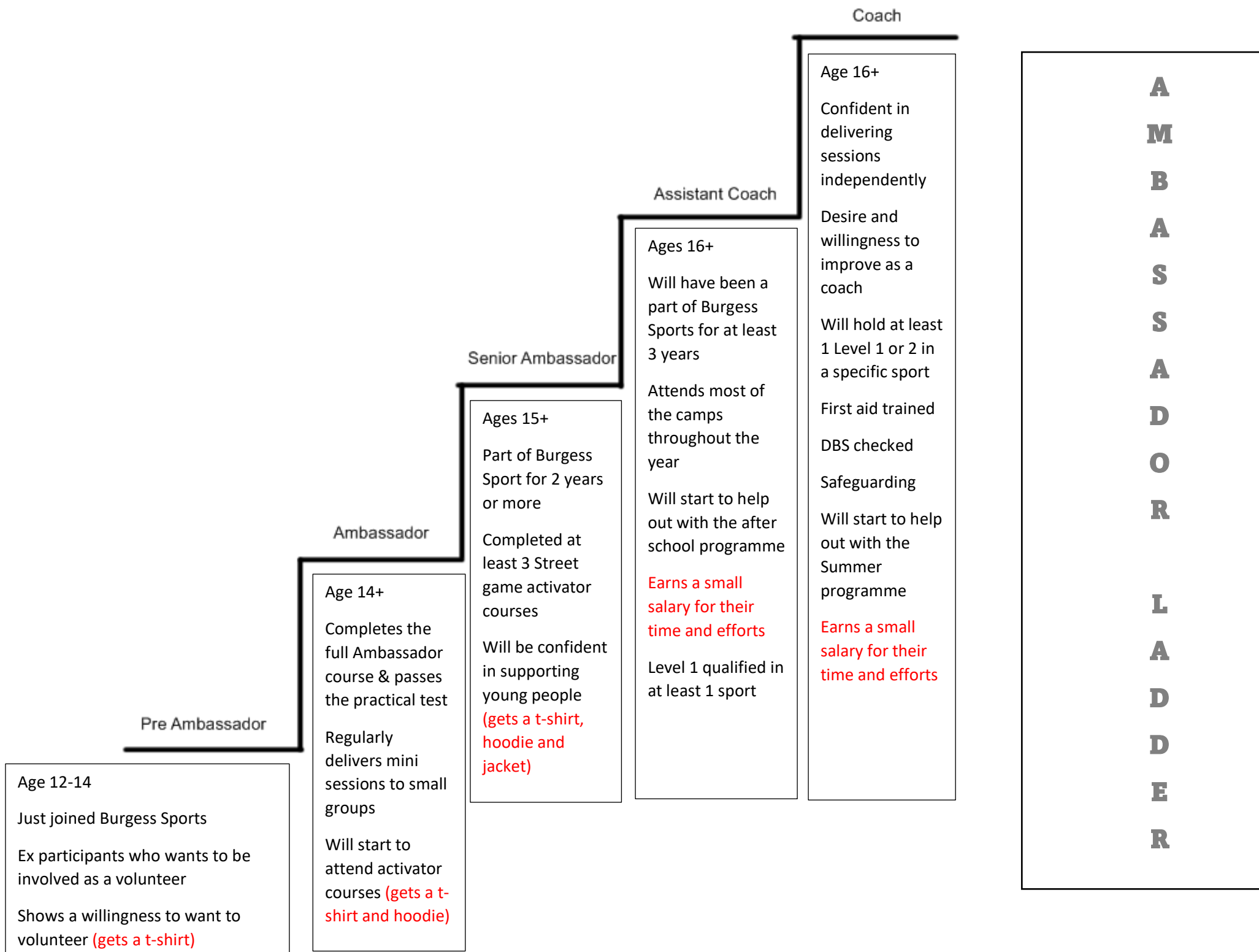
- To be enthusiastic and have a positive attitude towards the activities, coaches and participants
- To treat others with respect, being inclusive of diversity and promoting Burgess Sports values on equality, including gender, age, ethnic origin, religion, belief, sexuality or disability
- To do their utmost to ensure that all participants are included and valued without making assumptions about their backgrounds.
- Behaving in an open, honest and trustworthy manner
- Accepting responsibility and having accountability for your actions and decisions
- Acting reasonably in identifying and resolving conflicts of values, Knowing limitations and seeking for support whenever is necessary
- Seeking support if asked to act beyond your current level of capability
- Attending Ambassador course and other relevant training sessions/meetings in relation to the Sports Camps and other programmes
- Use only acceptable language and positive comments, even in difficult situations
- To call camp manager if you are late or cannot come for any reason

You Will not

- Use your mobile phone while you are in your role as an Ambassador in the Burgess Sports programmes.
- Take photos or videos of participants, or any other member of the camp
